HANDBOOK FOR THE PAPAL VISIT: These are available at the back of the churches on a first come first served basis. They are free of charge and include the Masses/Liturgies and music for the duration of the visit.

BEATIFICATION MASS - BIRMINGHAM: We are still waiting for the pilgrim packs and coach departure times. In the meantime please note the following. Pilgrims need to bring folding chairs, rugs etc for comfort, food/drink and any necessary medication. Please wear suitable clothing for changing weather conditions at this time of year. Everyone needs to bring photo ID (PASSPORT, DRIVING LICENCE, FREEDOM PASS, IDENTIFICATION CARD FROM AN OFFICIAL GOVERNMENTAL OR STATUTORY BODY) Let me know if there are any difficulties with this. If anyone pulls out for any reason, you must inform the Parish Office asap (No refunds can be given) This is for security procedures as all the lists - ours, the Diocesan list and The Bishops' Conference list have to be identical, otherwise we could be refused entry. No last minute substitutions can be made! As soon as more information is available we will be in touch.
