SACRAMENTAL PROGRAMMES

RCIA: The next session of the **Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults** will commence again during the month of **September**. The course that is run is for those interested in perhaps becoming a Catholic and for those Catholics who would like to grow in their faith and learn more about it. The course is very **user friendly** and the atmosphere is always relaxing. If you are interested or you know someone who is interested complete an application form and hand it in to the Parish Office as soon as possible.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION: Applications from parents who wish to have their children attend the course of instruction to enable them to receive their First Holy Communion during 2018 should complete an application form and hand it into the Parish Office by the beginning of **July 2017**. This equally applies to those children who attend St. Augustine's Catholic school and those who attend non Catholic Schools. **Minimum age Y3**. Forms received later than this date may well **NOT** be included in the **2017/18 group**.

CONFIRMATION: Applications from young people who wish to attend the course of instruction to enable them to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation during 2018 should complete an application form and hand it into the Parish Office by the beginning of **July 2017**. **Minimum age Y9** Forms received later than this date may well **NOT** be included in the **2017/18 group**.

APPLICATION FORMS for all three of these Catechetical Courses are now available in the Porch of the church. PLEASE ENSURE all completed forms are returned by the appropriate date.
